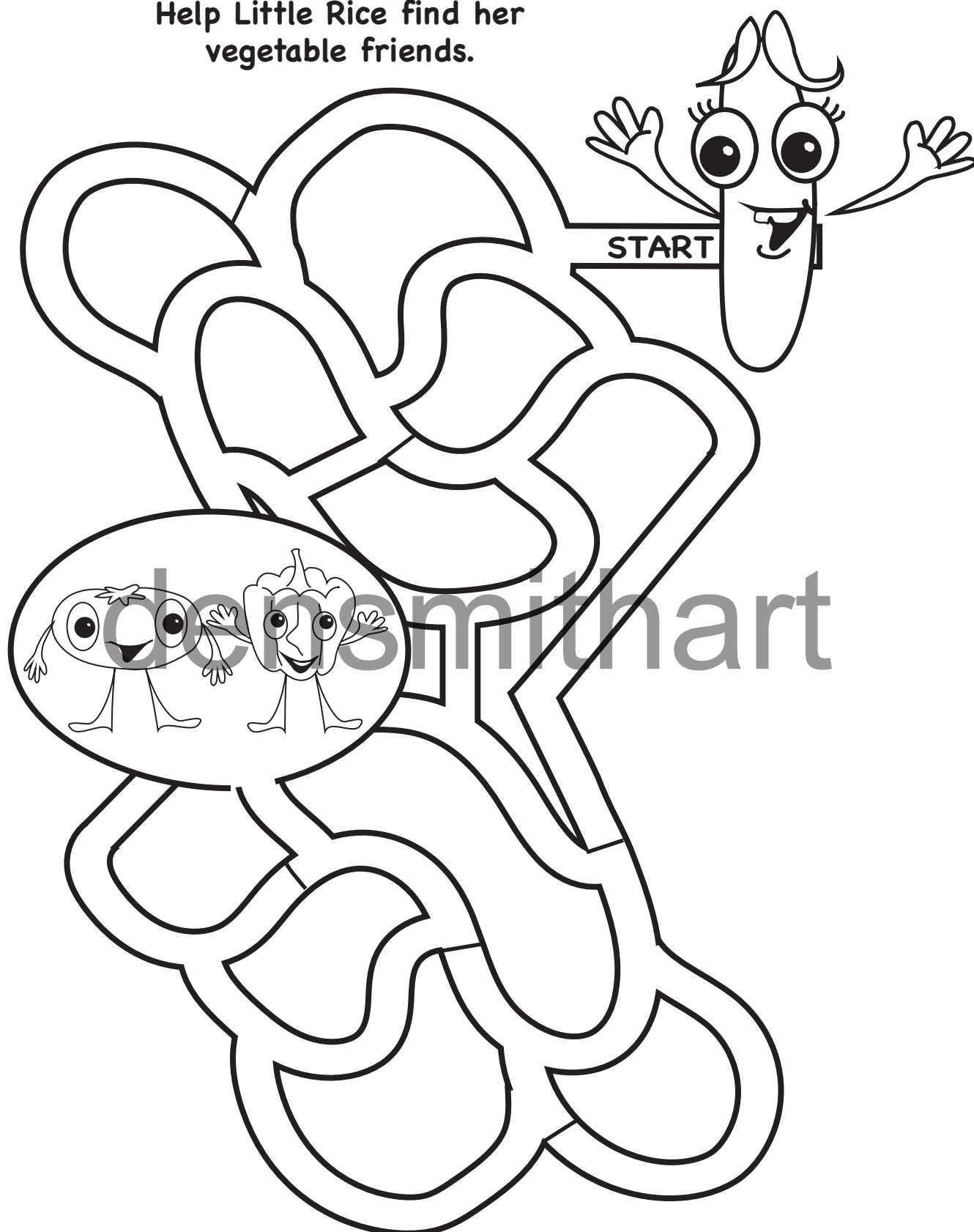

The Story of Missouri Rice:

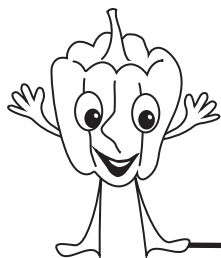
"Rice was brought to the Americas by accident. It began in 1685, when a storm-battered ship, sailing from Madagascar limped into the Charles Towne, South Carolina harbor. The kind citizens of Charles Towne helped repair the beaten ship. To repay their kindness, the Captain gladly made a gift of a small quantity of "Golde Seed Rice". This is the inspiration for this gift to you."

"Rice has been grown in Missouri for almost a hundred years. The first field in Missouri was located near Dudley (west of Dexter). In the year 2000, 175,000 acres of rice was grown in the southeast counties of Missouri (Cape Girardeau, Bollinger, Butler, Dunklin, New Madrid, Pemiscot, Ripley, Scott, Mississippi and Stoddard). This crop of high quality Missouri rice provides over 550 million pounds of ready to eat rice."

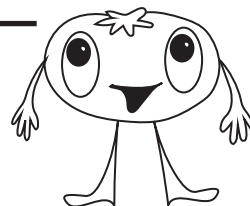
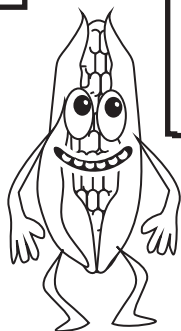
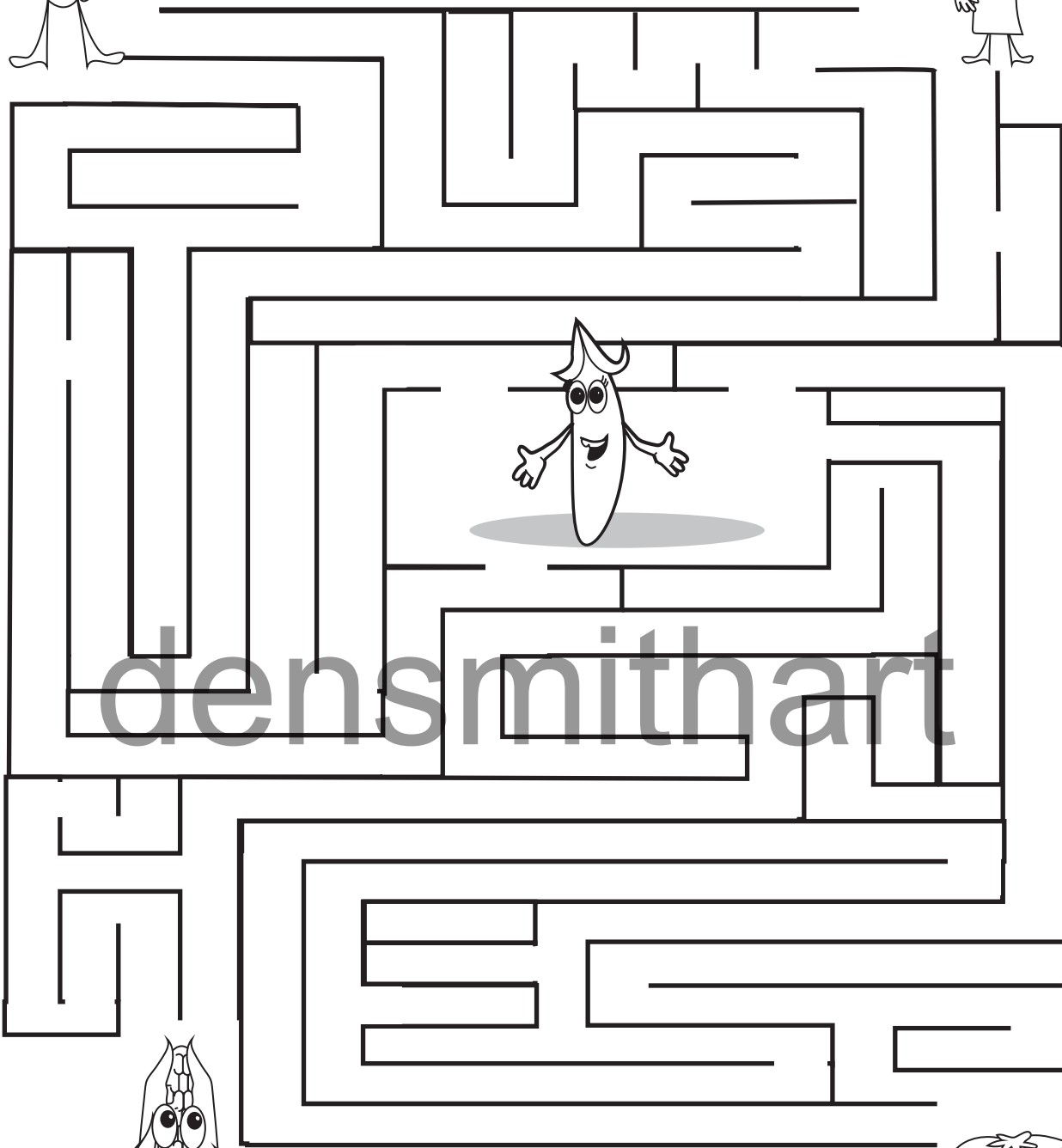
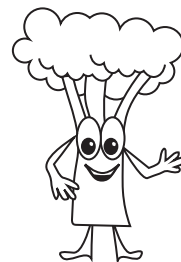

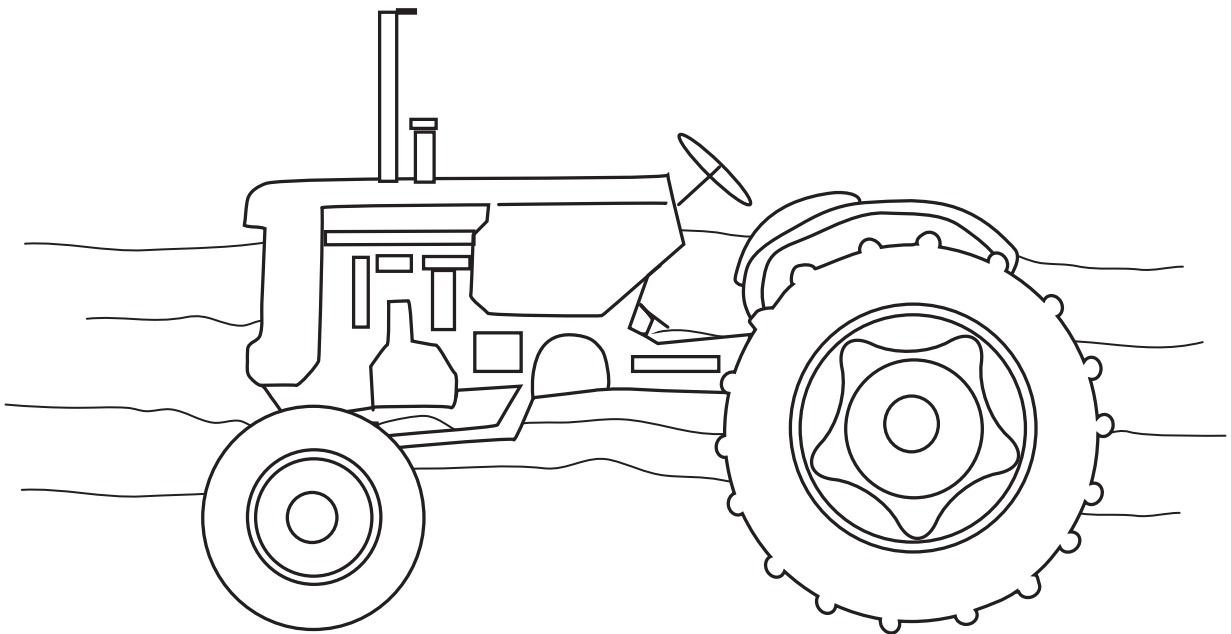
What can you GROW?

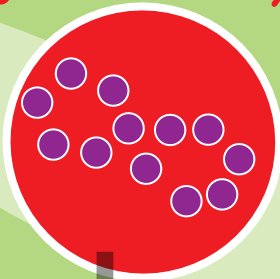
